**FOUNDED** in 1937 as a ministry of St. Philip Lutheran Church.

**LOCATED** on the north side of Chicago in one of the most diverse neighborhoods in the city.

**SPIRITUALLY** students' faith is nurtured and strengthened through weekly chapel services and daily religion lessons.

**ACCREDITED** by the National Lutheran School Accreditation (NLSA) the accrediting body for the Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod schools. NLSA has been accrediting Lutheran schools since 1978.

**FACULTY** are caring, experienced, dedicated, spiritually mature professionals. All of our teachers hold a bachelor's degree in their field and have more than five years of classroom experience. Additionally, over 50% of our teachers have been awarded a master's degree.

**DIVERSE** student body with 53 percent minority enrollment. Our students represent over 14 area churches.

**FACILITIES** include Smart Classrooms, technology and science labs, dance studio, library, and gymnasium.

**FINANCIAL AID** awarded annually for need-based assistance.

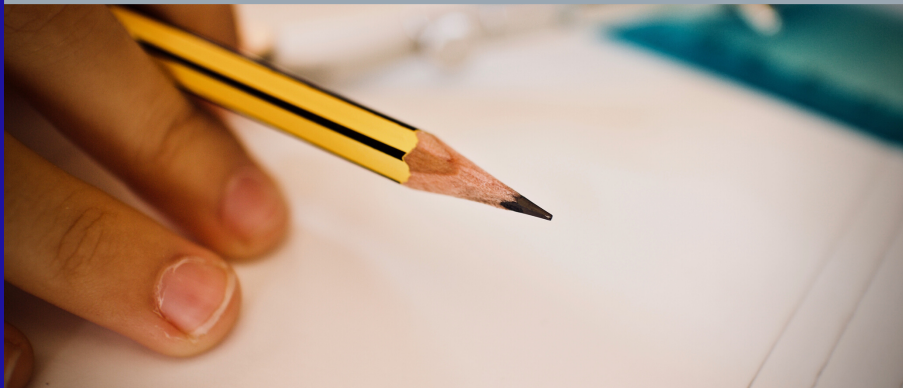
# *Inspiring* **PURPOSEFUL LIVES**
